

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What is the Cherry Creek Innovation Campus?**

Currently under construction, with an expected opening of Aug. 2019, the Cherry Creek Innovation Campus (CCIC) will be a stand-alone college and career preparedness facility accessible for high school students in the Cherry Creek School District. Courses at the CCIC will align with the industry standards for seven in-demand and growing career pathways: Advanced Manufacturing, Business Services, Health & Wellness, Hospitality & Tourism, Infrastructure Engineering (Building Trades), IT & STEAM, and Transportation (Automotive & Aviation).

### **Will the CCIC be a home high school?**

The Cherry Creek Innovation Campus will not be a (comprehensive) home high school, but will be a 'program' school students will attend part time, while continuing to take classes at their home high school.

### **Is there an application process to take classes at the CCIC?**

### **What will be the requirements to attend the CCIC?**

The CCIC will be available to high school students in the Cherry Creek School District. While most courses are designed for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students, each pathway may have specific requirements regarding age, grade level, and/or prerequisite courses. These specific pathway requirements can be found in the course information provided on the CCIC homepage. When selecting CCIC courses, it is important that students review their ICAP profiles with their school counselors, to ensure current graduation requirements are being met.

### **What if a CCIC course is also being taught at my home school?**

Some high schools offer courses which may also be offered at the CCIC. Students attending schools with these duplicate offerings should take the course(s) at their home high school.

### **Will transportation be provided?**

Yes, buses will transport CCSD students to and from their home high schools. Students may also drive themselves to the CCIC and park in the student lot.

**What will the CCIC class schedule look like?**

There will be four sessions available at the CCIC, two morning and two afternoon sessions on alternating (A or B) days. Most students will enroll in one session at the CCIC and attend their home schools for the remainder of their classes. Home high school counselors will work with students and families to ensure that the schedules align with ICAPs and graduation requirements.

**Will there be security on campus?**

The CCIC will have a School Resource Officer (SRO) and security personnel on campus. All visitors to the campus will be required to present identification at the reception desk.

**Will there be accommodations for students with disabilities?**

The CCIC will be an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant building. The building contains handicap accessible doors, parking, bathrooms, and elevators. For specific questions, please contact the CCIC main desk at 720-554-2600.

**Will there be a school nurse on campus?**

The CCIC will have a full-time, licensed school nurse who can address minor illnesses and dispense OTC and prescription medications as needed.
